Enrollment

Children must be 3 or 4 by September 1, and must be potty trained.

1/2 day 3 year old program: 8:15—11:30 M-F

Full day 4 year old program: 8:15—3:15 M,W,Th,F

8:15—2:15 Tuesdays

Class ratio: 1 adult per 10- students. Class Capacity 20 children.

Screenings and Assessments

Your child will meet with the teacher to do some assessments to help determine strengths and areas for growth. Assessments will continue throughout the year to document progress and to update goals. You will receive feedback from any assessments given during the year.

Service

Pre-School families are expected to contribute 15 hours of service to the school, as a part of the Volunteer and Fundraising Agreement, signed at admission. This time can be doing anything that is offered by the school as service. Opportunities are listed in the newsletter, on Schoolspeak and with the school volunteer coordinator.

Attendance

You will sign in your child each morning in the classroom. This is from 8:00-8:15. The children will have some morning work to do as they start each morning. You will sign your child out in the classroom each day at 11:30 (3 year-olds & 1/2 day 4 year-olds) and 3:15 (full day 4 year-olds). Tuesdays we dismiss at 2:15.

Open Door Policy

You are always welcome to come into our classroom! We love having help in the classroom. It is always nice to have an extra set of hands. You will be able to sign up to help at Back to School night in September. Projects can be sent home to prepare if you are unable to volunteer in the classroom. For the Safety of our children, you must complete a background check, and the Called to Protect training before you are able to work in the classroom or volunteer on field trips.

Personal Belongings

Each child will need a labeled backpack and a lunch box. You may send a blanket and small pillow to have your child use at rest time. The items will stay at school during the week and will be sent home on Fridays to be cleaned. Show and tell items are to be brought on your child's sharing day and the item needs to fit in their backpack.

Meals

Snack:

We have 2 nutritious small snacks a day for 4 year-olds and 1 nutritious small snack for 3 year -olds. You provide the snacks for your child. Please send two nutritious small snacks daily.

Lunch:

You have a choice of hot lunch to purchase from the school, or pack a lunch for your child. This is for full day Pre-K 4 only.

Milk: Nonfat Chocolate or 2% milk is available for purchase from the school

Birthdays

Your Child may celebrate at school with a simple treat. Please respect others when sending out invitations for home parities. They will only be sent from school if your child is inviting everyone or if it is a gender specific party.

Daily Routine

Pre-Kindergarten will join the school for the morning all school assembly. Your child will be responsible for hanging up their backpacks and coats.

Circle Time: Calendar, read aloud and whole group instruction happens at circle time.

Free Choice Time: The instructional assistant and teacher will work with small groups on learning activities and the children will have free choice time to play in learning activities: blocks, dramatic play, sensory table, puzzles, and practice being a part of a group, etc.

Show and Tell: Each week there is a letter theme for show and tell. Your child will have a specific day of the week that will be their sharing day. You will be emailed to update you on the themes. The sharing item needs to fit into your child's backpack. This time helps your child speak in front of a group and gives the other children a chance to be an audience and ask questions about an item.

Recess: We will have 2-3 15-20 minute recesses a day, weather permitting. We have our own pre-k playground off the class room. The children will follow the school recess rules which we will go over in class.

Rest Time: Is for pre-k 4 who are in our full day program. Sleeping cots are provided for your child. The cots are sanitized each week. Your child will have the same cot each day. Rest time is 30 minutes. If your child falls asleep, they may sleep for a bit longer. Parents will be contacted if there are issues around sleep.

Music/P.E/Art/Library:

Pre-Kindergarten 4 year-old Students will participate in all of these school activities. The 3 year old students and the half day Pre-K 4 students will participate as it fits into our daily schedule and the schedule of the school as a whole.

Mass

We attend Mass each Wednesday morning with the school. We begin the school year by attending half of the Mass for 3 year olds and whole Mass for 4 year olds. After Spring Break the 3 year olds start to attend the full Mass.

<u>Prayer</u>

We participate in the morning prayer at the all school morning assembly. We say a prayer before lunch. We say a prayer at the end of the day before dismissal. We learn: The sign of the Cross and the Our Father. We also practice the Hail Mary.

Field Trips

State regulations limit our potential to fieldtrips. For them to happen, each student would need to be traveling in a vehicle with their parent or one of the classroom teachers.
